PerL 1:1 (Personalized Learning)

All students at FAIR School Crystal in grades 5-8 are provided with Chromebooks to personalize and support learning inside and outside of the classroom.

Chromebooks will be distributed to our students during the first week of school. Distribution dates and information will be communicated in our August back to school letter.

Chromebook Insurance

- The insurance fee is \$37 per student. \$22 if the student qualifies for free or reduced price lunch. (Online payment is available.)
- Insurance covers accidental damage to your Chromebook.
- Insurance does not cover intentional damage.
- Stolen devices require a police report.
- Insurance does not cover charger or case.

Changes For the 2017-18 School Year

- **The first insurance claim is fully covered.**
- **For subsequent insurance claims, a \$25 deductible is applied.**
- **Students will be required to use a backpack with a laptop sleeve for transporting the device to and from school.**
- **Students may request a district-supplied case.**
