

# Robbinsdale Ambassador Scholarship Program is Looking for Candidates!

## Who's eligible to be an Ambassador Candidate?

Applicants must reside in, attend, or have graduated from the Robbinsdale Independent School District #281 or

Applicant/Parent/Guardian is currently working/volunteering for a business in the Robbinsdale Independent School District #281 area for 1 year prior to applying

There are three different age groups that both males and females can apply for (as of July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018):

- Seniors (ages 15-22)
- Middles (ages 10-14)
- Juniors (ages 5-9)

Previous Ambassadors for the Robbinsdale Ambassador Program cannot hold the same title twice.

They can, however, run again for a different title after 1 year away from the program. Previous Ambassadors of other communities must wait 3 years before they may run for a title in this program.

## What is time commitment if I am selected to be an Ambassador?

The ambassadors are very busy throughout the year with is a small event gap in the winter season. We do want Ambassadors to partake in and enjoy activities, and we believe that academics are very important. However, we also want the Ambassador Program to be a priority as well. Most of the events are in the evening and on weekends with the exception of some volunteer events. The summer is most busy as that is when many city festivals are hosted. During the summer, you can expect to have 4-6 events throughout the week. Parents are equally as important as the Ambassadors, because parents are needed to chaperone or help with the float. Time commitment is equally distributed among parents; Senior Ambassadors are often more busy than the younger aged Ambassadors.
